How to Get Started

“Every scout deserves a trained leader.”

Pack 88 is REQUIRED to have 100% of our leaders trained, in compliance with both BSA and our Charter Organization FUMCG. The fastest method to get trained is to take the online courses offered on the BSA training site my.scouting.org.

All Roles are required to complete 3 Sections of Training:

- **Youth Protection Training**
- **Position Specific Training** consisting of several individual Trainings
- **Program Safety Training** consistent of 5 individual Trainings

Here's a Summary of how to complete the training:

1. Create an account and Logon to <https://my.scouting.org/>
2. Click on BSA Learn Center
3. Follow the courses for you position listed below
4. Take all the courses in each module if they show incomplete

Even if you have already taken the online classes, the classroom training allows you to ask questions and get a better understanding of how things are really done.
